Assessing Official Comments:

QUALITY: During the SY 20-21, the LPS exceeded expectations by meeting all instructional requirements during the COVID instructional year. Recognized by the State of Massachusetts as being a school that never closed and never diminished services to students with disabilities, they were evaluated as one of the strongest public school systems in the state, ranking in the top 3%.

We are pleased to share that several students from Hanscom Elementary and Middle School were award winners at the State and National level for various content areas.

SCHEDULE: Lincoln Public Schools was able to maintain all instruction for all students with out variance. This area experienced COVID outbreaks interrupting education in several surrounding areas, however not for our students. We recognize and appreciate the diligence and effort executed by the LPS management to sustain school instruction.

COST CONTROL: This is a Firm-Fixed-Price contract, and therefore, no cost control rating is required.

MANAGEMENT: We attribute the high ranking of Hanscom Primary and Middle School by the State of Massachusetts to the exemplary management lead by the Superintendent, Director for SPED and building principals. During our site visits we see a cohesive team that spreads leadership throughout the staff at every level.

Also, the Air Force published a school quality report and the schools operated by LPS for Hanscom AFB were rated highly. We attribute this to the management team.

REGULATORY COMPLIANCE: TAs the contractor LPS met all federal and state regulatory requirements.

During the course of this year, DoDEA Security Management required LPS to provide

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an in-depth look at the background check compliance for an installation. The LPS was responsive and articulated in providing detailed information on the certification of employees. The LPS revised their Quality Control Plan multiple times in a timely manner and were able to prove full compliance.

ADDITIONAL/OTHER: We continue to appreciate the thoughtful detail the LPS provides for our students residing on Hanscom AFB because of the substantive, unique, most severe needs of our students in this location. However, it should be noted that with this unique case load of students with disabilities, the LPS teachers and principals continue to prioritize and meet the needs of ALL students and all types of learners.

The government is pleased to continue their relationship with LPS.
