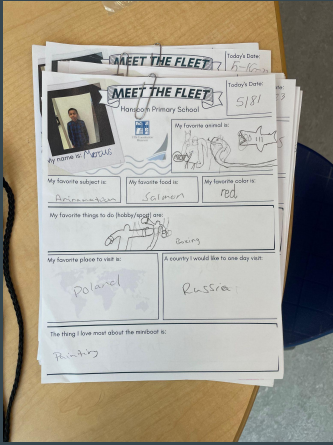

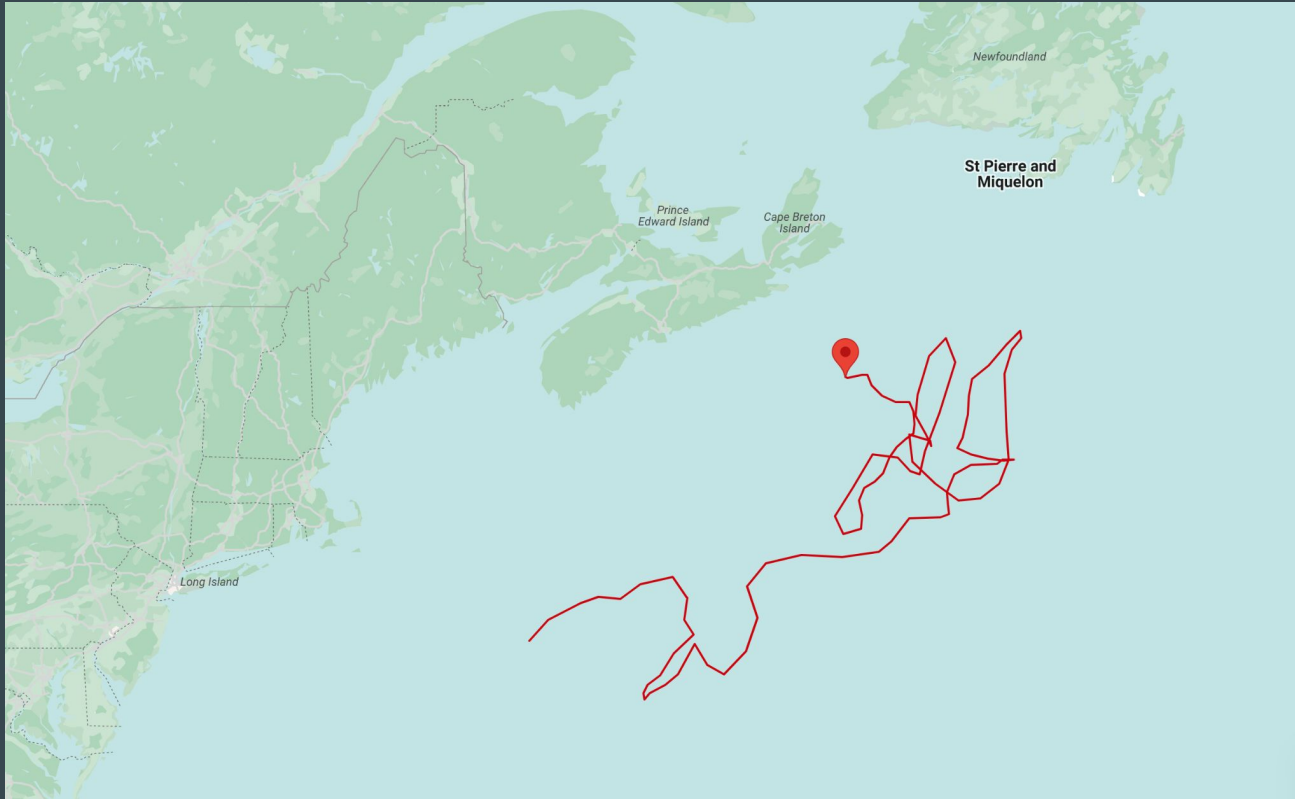
Ceremonial Launch of the “Warrior” in Boston Harbor on April 18, 2023



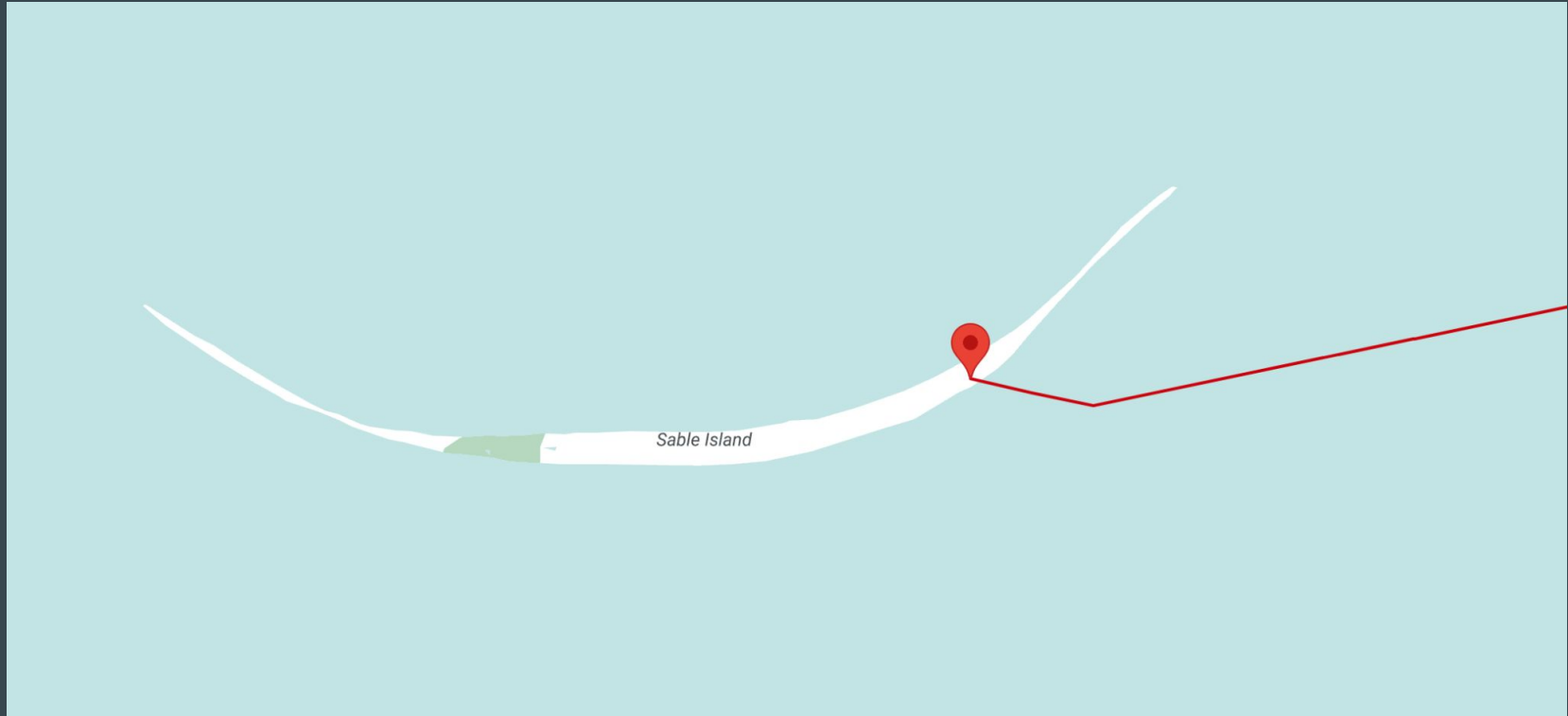

It had actually landed on a very remote island off the coast of Nova Scotia called Sable Island.



The boat was recovered on the island by a naturalist, Zoe Lucas on September 22, 2023 after 51 days at sea.
