

GOAL:



- Students reflected on their own strengths and interviewed family and friends to identify strengths others see in them
- Students reflected on how they developed strengths and sorted them into categories
- Students continue to add strengths to the charts living in their classroom communities



Ultimately we hope students continue to develop a growth mindset as they see that strengths can be developed over time.

5th grade

Create new cultural norms to establish team identity and culture that centers on trusting relationships and student voice.


Create multiple opportunities for student input on both the team and school level.


