### FY25 Budget Guidance and To-Line Request:

Requested Budget - LINCOLN	\$13,548,732
FY25 FinCom Guidance (+2.5%) + Medicaid (\$58,380)	\$13,548,732

Base Budget - HANSCOM*	\$19,061,834
FY25 Contract price	\$ 18,363,960

\*The proposed base budget is \$697,874 over the FY25 contract amount

### **Highlighted budget details**

- Maintains Hanscom dual AP structure for FY25
- Shifts previous one-time and pilot items into operating budget
- Eliminates Lincoln Assistant Principal and AIDE Director positions
- Creates budget flexibility for additional allocations for curriculum, PD, and AIDE work connected to entry plan findings and spring strategic planning
- Maintains the elimination of vacant positions
- Lincoln budget stays within the 2.5% guidance
- Hanscom budget projected to need a transfer from reserve fund

- Collective bargaining agreements for Education Support Professionals
- Enrollment Projections
  - Lincoln School kindergarten & grade 1
  - Hanscom Schools
- Final Calculations for Hanscom Employee Benefits

### **Potential Impacts & Budget Uncertainty**

#### • Expenses

- Special Education Out-of-District (OOD) Expenses
  - o We currently do not know our final CASE assessments and transportation costs
  - o Private School Tuitions are expected to increase 5% according to MA Operational Services Division (OSD)
  - o Tracking projected higher than normal OOD placements for Hanscom for FY25
- Facilities
  - o Timeline for solar panels to come online
  - o Potential Community Center project

### **PreK-8 General Education Sections - PROJECTED**

#### Hanscom Schools

- 12 HPS Classroom Sections grades K-3 (reduction of 1 section)
- Maintain 15 HMS Classroom Sections grades 4-8
- Lincoln School
  - 15 grade K-4 Classroom Sections (reduction of 1 section)

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- Maintain 14 grade 5-8 Classroom Sections
- Preschool
  - Maintain 5 Hanscom PreK Classrooms
  - Maintain 2 Lincoln PreK Classrooms

   Medicaid Appropriation <u>\$58,380</u>
- Total Town Meeting
- Hanscom revenue based on FY25 price set by latest DoDEA contract.
  \$18,363,960
- Reimbursement Programs (Circuit Breaker & E-rate)
- Grant revenues projected at level funding
- User fees estimated the same in FY25 as in FY24 (update to School Committee on any increases will be Jan. 25 Meeting)

## **Budget Votes - Lincoln School**

- School Committee approves the FY25 School Committee Budget of \$13,548,732 for the Lincoln School as presented by the Superintendent.
- School Committee requests Lincoln Annual Town Meeting to Appropriate the sum of \$13,490,352 from the Town's General Fund and the amount of \$58,380 from Medicaid Revenue received by the Town.

## **Budget Votes - Hanscom School**

- School Committee approves the FY25 School Committee Budget of \$19,061,834 for the Hanscom School as presented by the Superintendent.
- The School Committee authorizes the Superintendent to use up to \$697,874 of the Hanscom Reserve to supplement the US DoDEA contract for the School Year 2024 2025.
  - Hanscom US DoDEA Contract
  - Hanscom Reserve
  - Total Funding Required

\$18,363,960 <u>\$697,874</u> **\$19,061,834** 

• **NOTE:** The budget vote for Fiscal Year 2025 assumes \$400,000 for OPEB liability transfer to the Town is a funded line item along with all other benefit obligations of employees paid from the Hanscom Contract.
