- 1 instructional coach
- 1 METCO representative
- 1 English learner (EL) teacher
- 1 school leader (assistant principal or principal)

The committee will also include the Department Lead Teachers (DLTs) for Grades K-5 (Literacy) and 6-8 (English Language Arts), and will be led by the Literacy, Arts, Social-science, Humanities (LASH) Curriculum Specialist.
