**CITIZENS' COMMITTEES APPOINTED BY THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE**

The School Committee may from time to time invite citizens to serve on advisory, screening, search or study committees or to perform other tasks.

At such times the School Committee should provide clear expectations about the purpose and duration of the assignment and indicate how the results or recommendations will be used. The School Committee will give careful consideration to recommendations received but will use its own best judgment in making final decisions.

The School Committee should provide as much assistance or direction as is necessary and helpful for accomplishing the assigned task and should offer to such groups a copy of this policy and the more definitive "Procedures for Establishing Citizens' Committees", Policy Book BCF-R.
